

Wheeling Park Men's Golf Club Local Rules



- #1 Right of hole on or across road- OUT OF BOUNDS
- #2 Right of hole, on or across road or white stakes behind green OUT OF BOUNDS
- #3 Right of hole- OUT OF BOUNDS. All RED stakes play as lateral water hazard. Ball in creek behind green to the left of the bridge, player must use drop area if he/she does not elect to play from the hazard. You must use the drop area on the same side of the directions pole as your ball lies. If your ball lies on bridge or to the right of the bridge, proceed according to USGA rule 26-1
- #4 Right of hole White stakes OUT OF BOUNDS. Left of hole, lateral water hazard as marked, proceed according to rule USGA rule26-1. All flowerbeds are free drop, nearest relief, no closer to the hole.
- #5 "For clarity purposes", this hole is played as a lateral water hazard, any lost ball hit toward the hazard should be assumed to be in the hazard to speed up play
- #6 same as hole 5, however player, must use drop area if they elect not to play their ball from the hazard. Any ball closer to the green than the walking bridge uses the drop area by the walking bridge. All other balls must be dropped at the drop area near the cart bridge.
- #7 Behind green, white stakes OUT OF BOUNDS ball in hazard to right refer to USGA rule 26-1
- #8 Right side of hole and behind green, white stakes OUT OF BOUNDS
- #9 right side of hole, and new blacktop path to the right and behind the green is, OUT OF BOUNDS. Drainage ditch on left side of hole is ground under repair-FREE DROP

Special Notes

- 1. Ball may be moved with club head 12 inches or marked and placed by hand no more than 12 inches from the original spot, no closer to hole
- 2. A ball coming to rest within one club length of the trunk of a tree must be played as it lies
- 3. All split rail fence are immovable objects Rule 24-2
- 4. Nine hole scores must be posted
- 5. Ball lying on the bridges on #3 or #6 are deemed in the hazard as determined by the USGA
- 6. Tamping down spike marks is not permitted on putting greens
- 7. Abuse of the rules will not be tolerated, Please replace divots and repair ball marks
- 8. Please do not remove ball from the cup with club head
- 9. USGA approved rangefinders are permitted, distance only, no slope
